Whether you're just looking for a fun place to hang out, or you're a dedicated artist looking for space and extra training – we absolutely have SOMETHING for you.

Happening in June...

June 7 – Art Trippin Starts! (see below)

June 9 – Open Studio Starts! (see below)

June 23 – 27 – PHOTOGRAPHY – Join our team of student photographers (**grades 9 - 12**) for a week-long class with professional photographer Michael Wilson. June 23 – 27. We'll meet at Studio E every morning at 10am and then spend some time hanging out at Our Daily Bread, a soup kitchen in downtown Cincinnati. Learn to take amazing portraits in real-life settings. No charge to participate, all you have to do is fill out some easy forms. Loaner cameras available.

June 23 – 27 – PUPPETS FROM JUNK – Join our professional puppet-maker for a re-run of our spring break program – this time for **middle school students**. Make living creatures from ordinary junk. No experience or expertise required. Class meets daily from 1p – 4p with free dinner provided on the last day.

Happening throughout the summer...

We will be accepting artistic and literary contributions throughout the summer for a book of student work we'll be publishing. Join us for any of the opportunities listed below and work on YOUR submissions! Contact us for more details about this.

Join us for **OPEN STUDIO** (2nd floor): **Mondays 1p – 4p and Thursdays 5p – 8p**. Just show up at our 2nd floor studio behind St.Elizabeth's church – the entrance is on Lincoln Ave. Bring your own project, or use our paints and materials to start something new. A professional artist will be there working on his or her own stuff. No charge to participate. Just show up. (This is a great opportunity for "Art Trippin" students to continue their projects!)

Try **ART TRIPPIN'**: Field trips on Saturdays from 1p – 4p. Take an excursion with a professional artist to visit interesting and inspiring places around Norwood and all around Cincinnati. We'll supply a sketch pad and anything else you need. Learn to find art EVERYWHERE. Students are encouraged to continue their work at home or at our OPEN STUDIO (see above). Students who join us for at least seven excursions will be invited to a special session to gather their work in a custom-bound book. A modest charge of \$40 will reserve a spot in our cars for the whole lineup of excursions – this will cover

gas, bus fare, and museum admissions. Or attend just a few Saturdays for \$5 each (register at least a week in advance!). Financial assistance available.

Try **FLASH FICTION**: Thursdays 7p – 8p. An informal weekly meeting of writers and other creative folk for this fun activity that is part writer’s exercise, part game, part social event. We’ll provide the topic or inspiration, then you get twenty minutes to write a work of short fiction or poetry. We’ll post the favorites every week on our website – IF you want to share, that is.

AN OPEN CASTING CALL! Seeking students with an interest in storytelling, drama, or improvisation. You can be our resident troupe of performers this summer! Our program will be shaped in response to YOUR interests, and may include field trips to see theatrical events, rehearsing and performing drama and children's theater, learning and practicing creative storytelling for both children and adults.
